

Notice of Public Consultation on the Proposed Issuance of a New Licence for Providence Manor in Kingston

The Ministry of Long-Term Care (MLTC) is reviewing a proposal from Providence Care Centre (the Licensee) for issuing a new long-term care (LTC) home licence for Providence Manor (the Home), a 243-bed LTC home located at 275 Sydenham Street in Kingston, Ontario. The proposal involves:

- the development of 320 LTC beds that includes the Home's 243 beds and additional 77 beds allocated by the MLTC, subject to project approval and meeting all licensing requirements under the *Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007* (LTCHA); and
- the issuance of a new licence for 320 beds with a term of up to 30 years following the development of the Home at 1200 Princess Street in Kingston, Ontario.

In accordance with section 106 of the LTCHA, public opinion is being sought prior to a final decision being made relating to this proposal. If you have comments or opinions and would like to bring them to the attention of the MLTC, you may:
