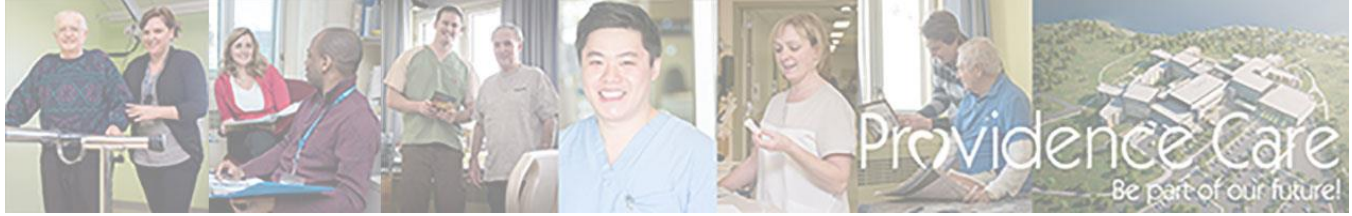
The Interventional Psychiatry Nurse will perform nursing care and clinical treatment activities related to Electroconvulsive Treatment (ECT), Post Anesthesia Recovery, Repetitive Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (rTMS), Intravenous (IV) Ketamine for Psychiatric Treatment, and nasal Esketamine according to Providence Care standards and the College of Nurses of Ontario scope of practice and standards. The Interventional Psychiatry Nurse will work in collaboration with the Physician and other members of the team.

Role Responsibilities

- Coordinate both inpatient/client and outpatient/client treatments for ECT, rTMS, IV Ketamine, and Esketamine inhalation by: scheduling client appointment; ensure required medical information and specific physician orders are in place
- Provide patient/client education regarding relevant treatment e.g.: ECT, rTMS, IV Ketamine, or Esketamine inhalation
- Perform pre-treatment assessment of patient/clients on day of procedure
- Communicate with treating psychiatrist regarding patient/client (e.g. physical condition, current medications, etc.)
- Assist Anesthesiologist and Anesthesiology Assistant during ECT treatment by maintaining adequate equipment supply (including syringes, needles, drugs, oxygen, anesthetic, etc.)
- Transport each ECT patient/client to treatment area (via stretcher) and subsequently recovery room, providing reassurance and ensuring safe positioning on stretcher
- Ensure that ECT documentation is completed by anesthetist re: dosage of drugs given, ensure narcotic count is maintained
- Document all ECT treatments, type, amount, dosage of drugs given, length of therapeutic seizure, etc.
- Monitor patient/client vital signs pre-, during, and post-treatment and discharge according to discharge criteria as required

Required Qualifications and Experience:

- Bachelor degree in a Nursing Program An equivalent combination of recent related education and experience may be considered
- Current unrestricted Registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario
- 6 months of acute or post-acute Medical-Surgical experience
- Basic Cardiac Life Support with Automated External Defibrillator training required
- One year of PACU or Critical Care experience or Critical Care Course, preferred
- Inpatient mental health nursing experience an asset
- Clinic nursing experience an asset.
